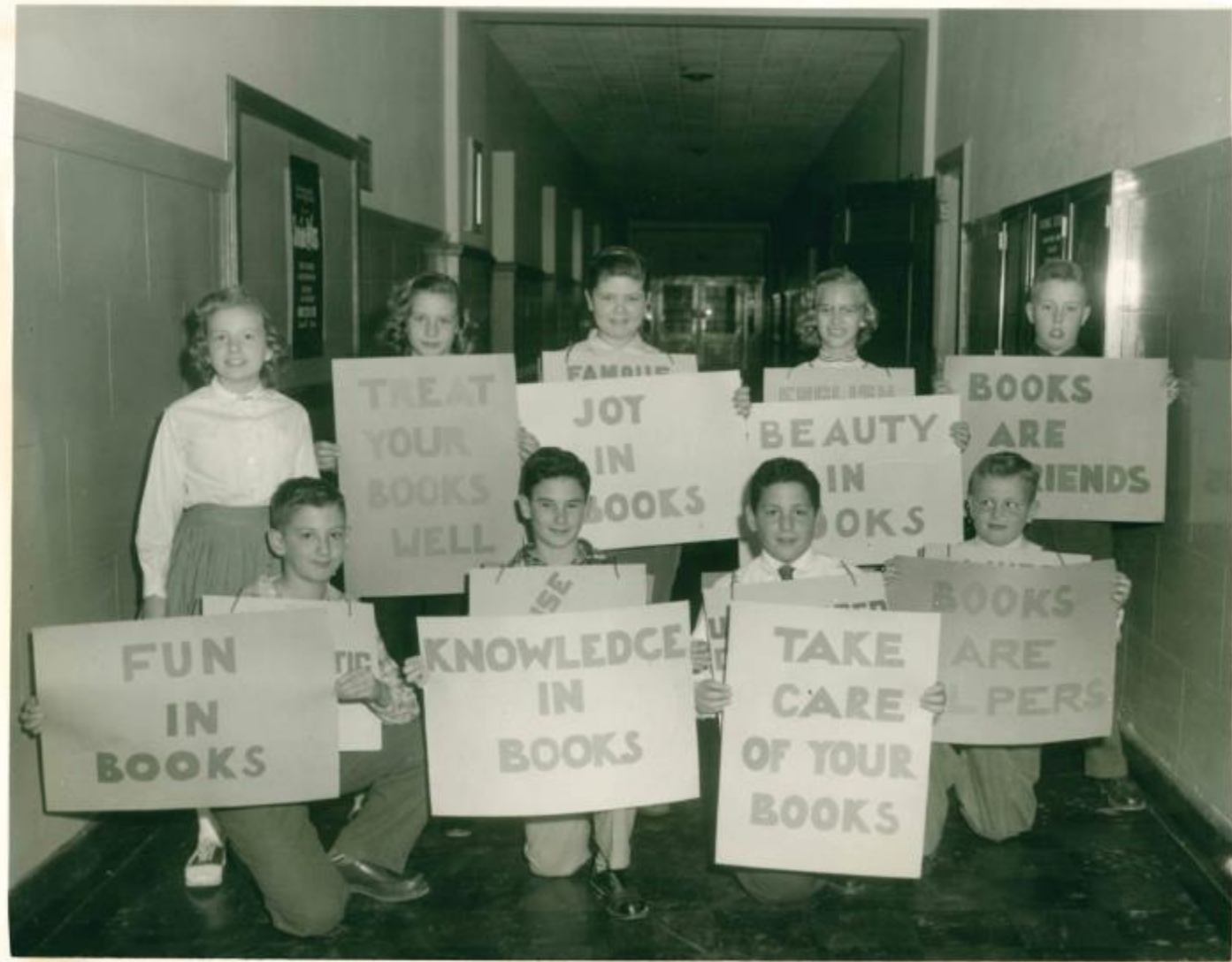

Architects rendering of new building—1967-1968



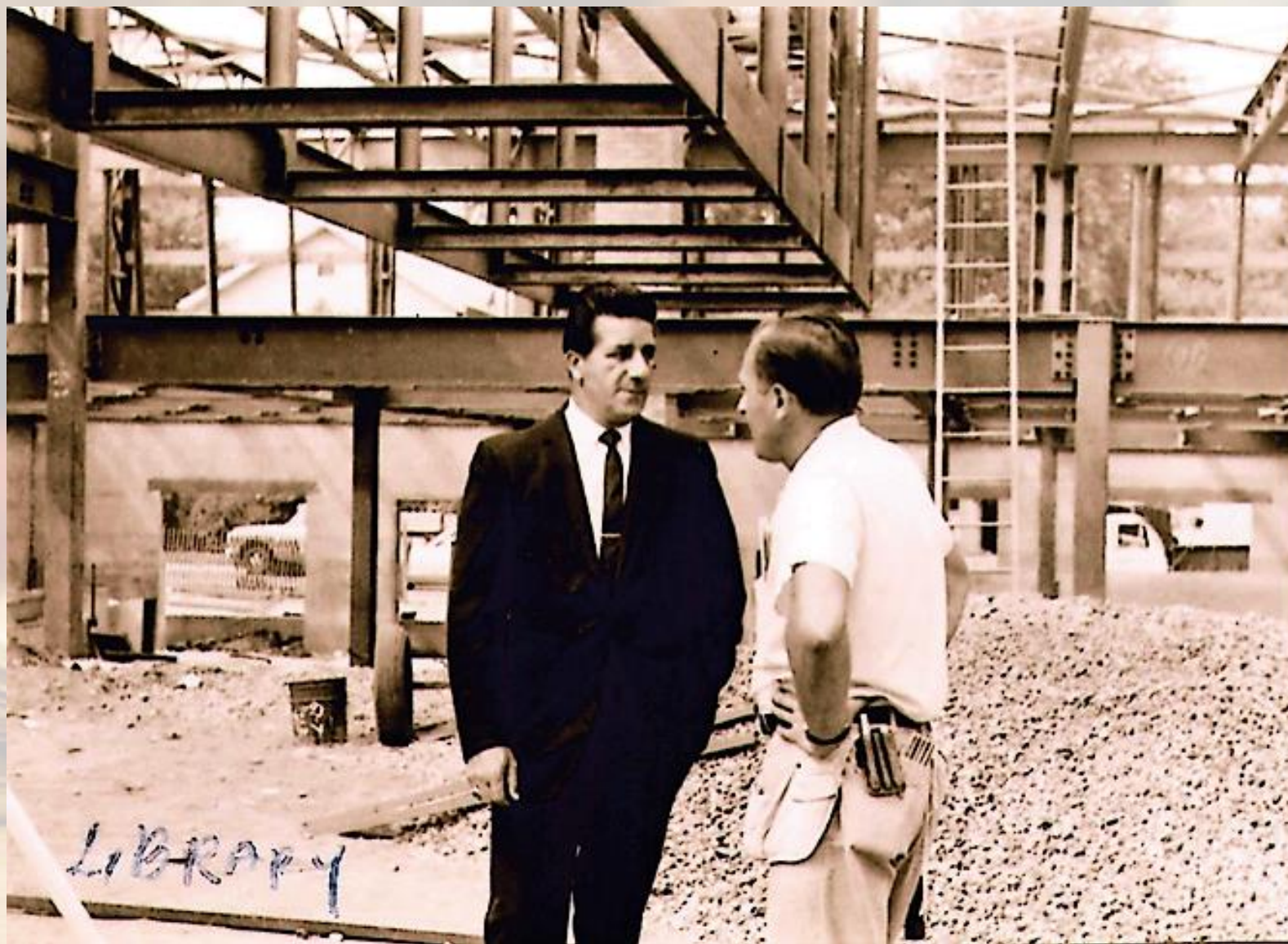

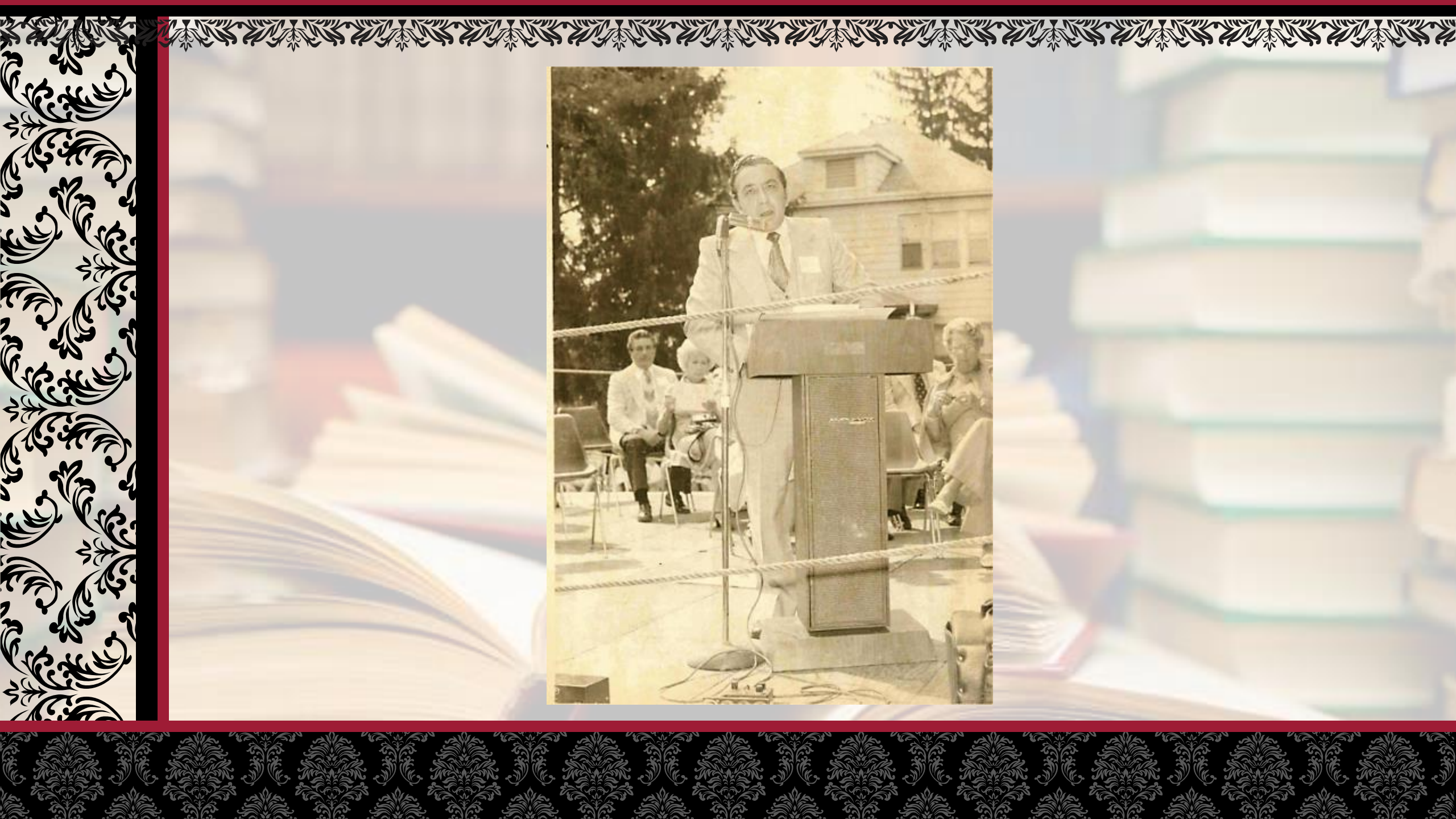
